Kingsburg Public Safety Committee Minutes
March 8, 2016 at 4:00pm

Call to order- Chairman Ben Creighton called the Kingsburg Public Safety Committee Meeting to order at 4:01 pm.

Approve minutes- A motion was made by Conni Delinger, seconded by Lennis Scheline, to approve the minutes from the February 9, 2016 Public Safety Committee meeting as prepared by City Clerk Abigail Palsgaard. Motion carried by a unanimous voice vote.

Continued discussion regarding Klaas Kids Foundation Print-a-thon

Ben Creighton said he wanted to review what was talked about and that the Klass Kids Print-a-thon will be next month. He said we received an invoice and we should send the check to them by next week. Mark Bray said he is working with the Fresno Sherriff's Office on getting a boat and a jet ski and maybe their new mascot. Ben Creighton said he was wondering where we are at with the flyer. He said they wanted a two sided flyer, both English and Spanish in color. Conni Delinger said she is going to ask MAC if she can translate it into Spanish. Judy Pagel said it needs to be on social media, Police Department's Facebook, Fire Department's Facebook, City websites. Ben Creighton said we need to follow up with Adam Castaneda to get it done. He said we need to distribute the flyers Monday before the event and that the deadline is 4/25 to distribute. Costs and activities at the event were discussed. Wayne Osborne said he has coloring books and he can try to get crayons. Conni Delinger suggested a McGruff coloring contest. Judy Pagel said she will get 100 sets of crayons from the Oriental Trading Company. She said she will also get a tank of helium and yellow and blue balloons and a \$250 check to the City as a sponsor. Ben Creighton said Sponsors should write their checks to the City and then the City will pay the vendors. He said he might need two reservations for the hotel, it is a nice touch if they can make it. Conni Delinger said we can eat at Malan's Friday night and Kady's for breakfast. Ben Creighton said he would like to know who can come. Whoever can come, email him or Conni so they can reserve a spot. He said the event is 10am-2pm. Conni Delinger asked about the food for volunteers, she said maybe Corsaro's. Ben Creighton asked that Conni Delinger speak to Tim, and order 5 or 6 huge pizzas and if we run out, we can get more. Conni Delinger said she is going to contact day cares to see if they want to have a sponsorship. She said she is going to get 250 or 300 small water bottles. Ben Creighton said he is going to speak to Rotary about sponsorship. Wayne Osborne said he can have tables and chairs out in the open. Ben Creighton said his wife mentioned it would be helpful to have a Spanish speaking person to help. Wayne Osborne said he might be able to have a Spanish speaking firefighter on duty. Lori Willson said she might be able to get a Spanish speaking interpreter from the high school. There was a discussion about having music, maybe a Disney channel.
