April 25, 2019 at 6pm

Call to order by Chair: Chairman Palomar called the meeting to order at 6:01pm.

Public Comments

Maddie Dix, Resident, spoke about vehicles speeding on Stroud, causing it to be dangerous.

Sherman Dix, Resident, Stroud is connected to the county and they speed on Stroud on their way out or their way in. Quite a distance without a stop sign, none from Madsen to 18th. He requested a stop sign at Stroud & 20th. A Motion to recommend a stop sign at Stroud and 20th to the Traffic Committee was made by Member Pursell, Jr. seconded by Member Ray, passed by unanimous voice vote of members present..

Brad Simpson, CHP, lives 20th and Stroud and agreed with the speeding on Stroud. Officer Simpson spoke about dangerous intersections, 5 out of the worst 10 intersections are in our area. He was able to secure a grant to add stop signs at those dangerous intersections. Officer Simpson briefed the Committee on the new law to enforce modified mufflers which will help stop illegal cars from the highways. It gives the officers the ability to have the cars to be inspected by the State.
