Camera Project Update

Chief Dadian said the Police Department has contracted with Kingsburg Media Foundation for their project. The biggest part was the storage center- infrastructure that we need to build. They added 2 cameras to Public Works and 3 to the Downtown park. Working on adding cameras to high use areas. 3 more cameras are going to Memorial Park. The cameras will be linked to FSO so they can have what we have and they can have what we have. He would like to eventually have mobile cameras. Member Pursell, Jr. asked if there will be 20 cameras. Reggie Gierke, Kingsburg Media Foundation, said they ended up 5 at Athwal, 5 at City Hall, 2 at Memorial Park, 2 at Public Works, with additional cameras in the future. Member Pursell, Jr. thinks what Reggie has done is amazing,

Member Sembritzki would like to suggest using funds for the crosswalk at Sierra & 18th.

Member Pursell, Jr. supports the camera project.

Committee gave Member Pursell, Jr. direction to research what the committee can get for \$10,000.

Chairman Palomar congratulated Member Brandon Pursell, Jr. on becoming a new council member for District 3, starting 12/2020.
