II. Approval of minutes – Safarjian

III. Public Comments – Safarjian

IV. Business Park Update – Polyack

Two owners are planning on erecting spec buildings in 2016. A business is planning on relocating to the Business Park from Fresno. They will purchase a lot and build. A new listing may be coming soon. There was an offer for two lots, however the seller didn't accept the offer. We continue to work with the majority owners in order to help facilitate development in the park. A direct mail piece will be sent to all brokers in the area regarding access to the new website. Traffic to the kingsburgbusinesspark.com website continues to steadily increase.

V. Economic Development Update/Draper Street – Polyack

A discussion on ways to bring entertainment venues to the downtown corridor was discussed. Roman will speak to Valley Health on possible sites for their health care facility. The Larson property is for sale and has offers. RPS has two listings one on each side of Highway 99.
