



The **Lock It Up Project** is a primary partner of the Women's Initiative (An initiative of the United Way of Fresno) alliance called the **"Lock It Up. Clean It Out. Drop It Off."** This alliance consist of community organizations, pharmacists, school districts, local government and law enforcement agencies working to keep prescription drugs away from kids, youth, young adults, and out of the environment.

The alliance has placed drop-off boxes throughout the county, in secure locations for the disposal of prescription drugs. Expired and unwanted prescription medication can be dropped off in these boxes where they will be collected daily for safe disposal.
