When disposing of household medication, both prescribed or over the counter, place the container with the medication into a sealed plastic bag before deposit. When disposing of Sharps (needles, lancets, razors, etc.) place them into a Sharps Container or us may use a rinsed, cleaned and sealable household detergent bottle to collect and dispose.

CRT (Cathode Ray Tubes): Screens such as those found in TV and Computer Monitors. Small Appliances are accepted however this varies from company to company. The most common items accepted are: computer-related items such as mice, keyboards and printers. A few companies accept non-computer related items, usually for a fee (e.g., small office machines, toasters, hair dryers, players and recorders, electronic games and toys and other items that have mercury on-off switches). None of these providers take large appliances (e.g. washers, refrigerators, etc.) For disposal of large appliances, contact your solid waste hauler or call the County of Fresno Planning and Resources Division at (559) 600-4259.
