The Committee expressed support for requesting additional funding. Member Roberts also requested ongoing updates on the performance and effectiveness of the body-worn cameras and the drone program.

Dave Silva, resident and Council Member, expressed support for upgrading the cameras, stating it is a worthwhile investment.

The Committee discussed safety concerns related to the bike lanes on Draper Street, as well as the recent incident involving the Christmas tree being struck.
