### **Regular Meeting Minutes**

### **Police Crime and Camera Update**

Sgt. Kroeger and Officer Gagnon shared crime stats. Vandalism at parks and schools due to TikTok challenges. Created a video to let the community know Kingsburg Police Department takes it seriously and want to keep the community clean and safe. People can report anonymous and the Police Department is practicing zero tolerance. Sgt. Kroeger said they are working on cold homicide case. People in custody for homicide by Cody Lane. Landlord tenant dispute occurred were there was an assault weapon and they recovered ghost guns. They are investigating sex crime against underage girls. The camera at Memorial Park is assisting officers. The committee discussed vehicle crimes and catalytic converter theft. Sgt, Kroeger said it is an issue in all of Fresno County. The committee asked about TikTok. Officer Gagnon said it is something parents should monitor, it is almost like dares but it is property damage or inappropriate touching. Sgt. Kroeger said the department is moving towards body worn cameras.

### **Use of Funds Discussion**

Chairman Palomar has been talking to Chief Dadian regarding body cams. He had asked Officer Fuentes about any needs for a new sped trailer. No need. Would like to help fund the body cams. Member Roberts asked if we could get a breakdown of the cost and ongoing storage.
