 "Kingsburg BID" hashtag that can be used by all businesses, if desired.
- Drive leads and sales for BID members
 Post information about specials, sales, or events that are coming up for the businesses individually or as a whole. This should promote more customers/clients to shop in the downtown district of Kingsburg.
- Spread exposure equally between the businesses

 Monitor business exposure to ensure equal representation on social media pages.
- Report social media metrics monthly to the BID advisory board Highlight increase or decrease in audience exposure.
