Regular Meeting Minutes
August 16, 2021

Call to order by Chair: Chairman Palomar called the meeting to order at 4:05pm.

Members present: Alan Roberts, Vincent Latham, Lennis Scheline, Shawn Marshall and Chairman Vince Palomar.

Members absent: Thom Sembritzki, Jim McGuire, Kenny Crab, and Fred Ray.

Staff present: City Clerk Abigail Palsgaard.

Public Comments:

Lee Darling, resident, would like to have more cross walks around Reagan. Would like one on Avenue A/Lindquist, better for the kids to walk around the school instead of crossing all of the streets. Issues with the skate park, likes the playground and canopy, but kids are using terrible language and forcing the kids to go to other areas. Trees have steel poles under them. Would like a larger police presence. Would like more police patrols around the schools during drop off and pick up. Would like the crosswalk by the park to be re-painted and lit. Would like more patrol at the Concerts in the Park. Doesn't like the u turns or jay walkers. Asked about SRO. Confirmed that there is one for all of the schools.

Approve Minutes: Member Roberts motioned, seconded by Member Marshall, to approve the minutes from the May 17, 2021 Public Safety Committee meeting as prepared by City Clerk Abigail Palsgaard. The motion passed by unanimous voice vote of those members present.

Use of Funds Discussion

Chairman Palomar said the committee has \$10,000 in funds. We have used it for crosswalks and cameras in the past. Member Roberts would like to fund a camera at the baseball field and enquired about the safety of citizens at city events. Chairman Palomar said the Chamber partners with the police department and our events are safe.

Chairman Palomar discussed the possibility of neighborhood watch. Member Scheline said we tried 5-7 years ago and there was not a lot of participation. Member Roberts said we can look at technology for this. It has to be current and fresh. Virtual neighborhood watch. Would like to ask the Police Department if they think it is useful.

Other Business

Chairman Palomar brought up 10th and Kern- speeders. Discussed radar trailer. Member Roberts said would like empty PD vehicles parked by patrol trailers. Chairman Palomar would like send a request for a stop sign at 10th and Kern. Member Marshall suggested Draper and 10th before the school.
