Presentation by Council Member Hurtado

Council Member Hurtado shared a personal experience of coming out. She stated that this is not for personal agenda or to further her political career. This is for the young people who reached out to her who were afraid, who were told they were not loved. She spoke about the Stonewall riots and the movements in the 1960's. She reviewed mental health issues and others. She stated that this is one step that our great City can make towards showing support for our own LGBTQ+ residents and how we can show our residents our acceptance by flying the rainbow flag at City Hall. She said that this is one step for making people feel safe and loved and who does it hurt?

Council Discussion-

Council Member Pursell, Jr. stated that he does not believe it is City business. He believes it is a personal action. Council Member Hurtado wants to make LBGQT+ feel that they are members of the community. He stated that those that want to see a flag have that in Jewel. It is a pure and democratic representation. He stated that you, Council Member Hurtado, are that voice. He stated that he does not support the proclamation or the flag.

Council Member Hurtado stated that people of this community do have representation, but it wasn't done for me. She said that she can see where the flag is too much and asked if can we meet in the middle with a proclamation? She asked if opening Pandora's box is that a bad thing? She said she agrees that we should have a group for support.

Mayor North said that this cannot be based off our personal beliefs. We are voted in by our constituents. We do have some issues to solve. A proclamation and flag will not solve them. We need to work to make these people feel more accepted. This isn't a government issue; it is a community issue. She would like Council to support youth mental health and said that maybe we can use ARPA funds for counseling.

Council Member Palomar spoke about how Kingsburg is a great community. We all look out for each other. No matter your race or sexuality, you are accepted. He said that, as an elected official, I will not bring my own personal issues to Council. I want to bring issues that bring us together. He stated that he feels for the young people who are going through these issues. A Kingsburg Pride Group or Anti-Bullying are good ideas.

Council Member Roman said that she wants to commend everyone for coming forward. We have heard people open their hearts about other things we can do. We must listen to both sides of a community reaching out. Diversity and acceptance are important. Love thy neighbor. She said that she appreciates Alyjha (Ally) Tauscher bringing up the Kingsburg Pride. There are other things we can do, such as, collaborating with schools and churches. She said that you cannot deny suicide rates and mental health for LBGTQ+. She asked how we can support this group more?

Council Member Hurtado said that we just heard everyone proclaim their support. That is all she is asking. She said that she feels it is not going pass tonight and it is heart breaking. This is all for the kids.

Council Member Pursell, Jr. stated that he wanted to clarify that just because he doesn't support the flag and the proclamation doesn't mean he hates the group.

Council Member Hurtado said that she is not ready to let it go because she has been waiting 3 years to bring this up.

Mayor North stated that part of unity is not elevating one group over another. We do need to support all our youth. We are Kingsburg, we are in this together. Not one group elevated or better than another. Through that, we are making them different. She said that she would support a proclamation to support all people being against bullying and that we all love each other.

Council Member Palomar stated that, overwhelmingly, his constituents do not want this.

Council Member Roman said that she hopes that those who support it, or feel unsafe, will come to us if they need assistance.

Council Member Hurtado said that she would like to use funding for counseling. She wants everyone to know they are loved. She would like a sub-committee and support Kingsburg Pride and get resources from Fresno County EOC.

Mayor North stated that public comment was that they want a safe community.

Council Member Hurtado made a motion to adopt the proclamation. Mayor North declared that the motion died for want of a second.
