






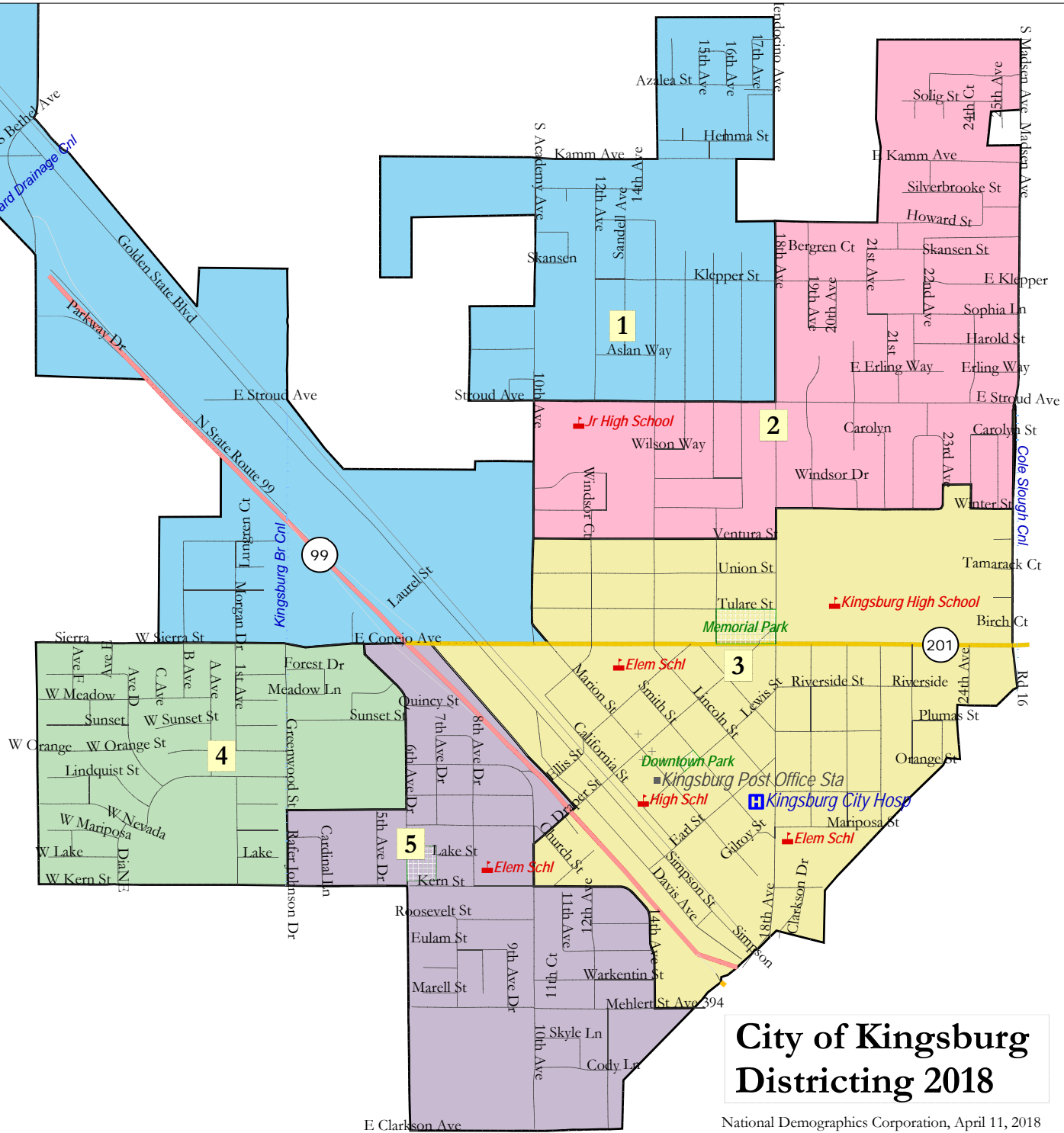


Public Map 102
